## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE CREATION AND FUNDING OF A TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT**

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held on December 3, 2009, at 6:00 p.m., at the Creve Coeur Government Center, 300 N. New Ballas Rd., Creve Coeur, Missouri 63141, on the creation and funding of a transportation development district by the name of the "Olive/Graeser Transportation Development District" (the "District"). A petition has been filed requesting formation of the District for the purpose of funding the transportation projects set forth in the petition (the "Transportation Projects"), summarized as follows:

All hard and soft costs of aligning Dautel Lane and Graeser Road, installing traffic signals at the intersection of Olive Boulevard and Dautel/Graeser, and certain projects in connection therewith, including but not limited to widening Olive Boulevard and installing medians on Olive Boulevard from east of the Dautel Lane/Graeser Road alignment to Schulte Road (with one median break); and \$68,000 for the cost of net right of way dedicated for the relocation of Dautel Lane and any costs to acquire any necessary right of way along Olive Boulevard, other than on the property to be owned by the proposed developer.

If approved by the owners of record of all real property within the District, the Transportation Projects will be funded by a transportation development district sales tax of 1% of all taxable sales at retail within the District. A copy of the petition is on file and available at the office of the


