



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY CONCRETE REPLACEMENT CITY OF CREVE COEUR, MISSOURI

PROPOSALS DUE: 1:00 PM, FRIDAY, APRIL 10, 2020

The City of Creve Coeur seeks proposals for the replacement of section of concrete pavement at the Public Works facility at 996 E. Rue de la Banque Street. The section of the concrete to be removed and replaced measures approximately 270 square yards.

The replacement area is on the east side of the facility, just north of the auxiliary salt dome.

Scope of Work

The work involves removal of an approximately 60-foot by 40-foot section of existing asphalt pavement and gravel parking lot. The removal limits will be indicated by the Director of Public Works. The extent of the pavement removals shall be saw cut to straight and neat lines. Excavation shall include the amount of the subgrade necessary to reach a depth of approximately fourteen (14) inches.

After removal of the existing pavement, four (4) inches of compacted base rock shall be installed. Replacement of the pavement shall be ten (10) inch thick fiber-reinforced concrete pavement with a minimum 28-day strength of 4000 psi.

Fiber-reinforcement shall be Fibermesh Microsynthetic Fibers or approved equal. Bidders should include the information on the type of fiber with their proposals.

All work shall be completed according to the attached technical specifications and to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works.

Method of Measurement. 10-inch concrete pavement shall be measured to the nearest square yard.

Basis of Payment. Payment for Concrete Removal and Replacement, Fiber-Reinforced (10" Thick) shall be according to the contract unit price per square yard, which shall include all mobilization, traffic control, sawcuts, removals, disposal of materials, base rock, concrete, construction signage, and all material, equipment, labor, and tools necessary for this work.

This work shall be completed no later than June 12, 2020.

Proposals shall include the attached Itemized Bid Form or a similar form to submit a bid. Proposals will be accepted by the City no later than **1:00 p.m. on Friday, April 10, 2020**, and shall be **emailed** to:

Bids will be reviewed in a public online meeting on Friday, April 10, shortly after the bidding deadline. Bidders will also receive this information directly from staff.

The City reserves the right and sole discretion to reject any and all Bids and to waive all informalities in Bids. No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days, subsequent to the specified time for receipt of Bids. No low Bidder shall have a business expectancy merely because his Bid is the lowest one received: until the contract has been awarded, no business expectancy exists. Bids may be withdrawn solely for demonstrated and verifiable clerical or typographical mistake, but not mistake of judgment. Bids will be considered unresponsive if they contain any material defect or deviation.

Equal Opportunity and Non-Discrimination

The contractor shall comply with all applicable Equal Employment Opportunity and Non-Discrimination regulations and shall provide an affidavit to this effect with the executed contract.

Insurance and Permitting Requirements

The successful contractor will be required to procure and maintain insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 for workers' compensation, comprehensive general liability, comprehensive automobile liability, and owner's protective bodily injury insurance for the duration of the project. The City shall be named an additional primary insured on the certificate of insurance. Proof of insurance will be required.
