
Dear Mr. Cannon:

MoDOT Traffic has reviewed CBB's Traffic Impact Study regarding the proposed Quik Trip #613, located at the southwest corner of Olive Blvd. (Missouri Route 340) and Graeser Rd. in Creve Coeur, and offers the following comments.

- MoDOT concurs with the recommendation of providing right turn bays for the proposed right-in/right-out entrance and at Graeser Rd. and will require such on the permit plan.
- MoDOT will also require conversion of the existing permissive-only (3-section) flashing yellow arrow indication for northbound Graeser Rd. to a protected-permissive (4-section) flashing yellow arrow indication to help mitigate the projected increase in the northbound approach delays.
